- Do you want to keep the carpet base? Yes.
- 2. Just the back (west) wall?

Yes and the center column.

3. How will panels be attached to wall?

Follow recommendation of vendor providing panels, make sure to mention wall is made of concrete.

4. How much of the wall paneling will be removed?

All will be removed. If needed, wall will be fixed. Then panels that are good/straight will be used for bottom third of wall (same height as rail).

- 5. What type of decorative trim will be used between old and new panels? Something simple to match rails.
- 6. Is the projector screen electric?

No. It will need to be removed and reattached.

7. How will panel be added where exit sign is at?

Have power box extends so it's flush with panels surface, exit sign will be mounted to box extender, with sign seating flush on new panel.

8. Work is to be done outside of business hours?

Yes, work is to be done during nights, weekends and holidays.

9. Which days are Court holidays?

10. Will the seats need to be removed?

12. Is upper ledge & ceiling hot?
